R09.12.010. General Statement: Protection of Minors

The University of Alaska system, as part of its mission, promotes and engages in many programs, events and activities that involve minors throughout its separately accredited institutions and campus locations.

Child

Abuse or neglect may be inflicted by any person



and may include minor-to-minor abuse or Authorized Adult-to-minor abuse. For purposes of this policy, abuse may include, but is not limited to, the following types and descriptions:

- 1. Physical Abuse means hitting, spanking, shaking, slapping, unnecessary restraints;
- 2. Verbal Abuse means using degrading, or threatening language, including using foul
